2. Minutes of Previous Meeting

3. Matters Arising (other than those on the agenda)

4. Section 1

MC outlined the new MSCDRP groupings and impact on our relative performance. **MC** also outlined the overview report (3 month summary) and the performance summary (12 month assessment).

The group discussed the performance strategic assessment which is currently being worked on and developed.

There is a need for activity to be monitored more robustly in the future.

JEH raised the issue of how drugs and alcohol should be reported and monitored through the group. The group endorsed that the national indicator be inserted into the community plan and will be reported upon exceptionally.

5. Section 2

Town Centre Task Force – Ali Reynolds

Councillor Paul Bell is now the Chair for this group. The action plan is progressing well. A multi-agency EVA (environmental visual audit) of the town centre is planned for the near future. Violence is downward on the town centre currently.

Vehicle Crime – Ali Reynolds

AR outlined the progress of Operation Ramble. Reporting in country parks has been significantly reduced. However, auto-crime, specifically, theft of motor vehicle has increased significantly since Jan 08. Number plate thefts are still high and a cause for concern.

ASB Group – Elly Simms

The ASB processing group currently has 10 cases. There are 8 anti-social behaviour contracts in the borough and 3 additionally have been initiated by Wellingborough Homes.

There is currently a protocol being developed.

Domestic Violence Forum – Nicola Hicks

The group has commissioned a piece of work through Compass to inform and support the development of a robust action plan.

DAAT – Joe Hubbard

The next local substance misuse group meets in July and **JEH/CS** to feedback at next meeting. The group will be looking at membership.

6. Section 3

AR informed the group that the top 2 crime beats are Hemmingwell and Swanspool. Action plans have been developed and circulated.

Action – NH to ensure that Keith Smith contacts **AR** re cleanliness measure.

AR circulated an outline summary of SCT activity. Good work is progressing at this level.

KM informed the group that there are currently 7 PPOs in catch and convict. No new PPOs were selected or de-selected at the last meeting.
